NEW MASSACHUSETTS LAW AIMED TO ACCOMMODATE BREASTFEEDING MOTHERS IN THE WORKPLACE

Frosted window film helps create mandated privacy

Boston, MA, April 1, 2018– On July 27, 2016, Massachusetts Governor, Charlie Baker signed into law, the "Pregnant Workers Fairness Act." A measure to prohibit unfair treatment or discrimination by an employer against an individual due to pregnancy or any other condition related to pregnancy; nursing, etc.

The law takes effect today, April 1, 2018. As an effective measure to create a private space for a nursing mother, companies can select certain spaces within their offices to create such places for new mothers. Our products, particularly frosted window film made by Llumar[®] Window Film, help to create these private spaces with a <u>low cost</u> retrofit – by adding the frost to the glass, creating privacy.

Anyone contacting us during the month of April will receive 20% off the costs of adding frosted film to existing workspace glass, and thus, provide required privacy to keep in compliance with the new law.
